Thank you for auditioning and/or interviewing for our Fall Productions. The Directors and Staff truly appreciate the time, dedication, and effort that you put into this process. Creating the cast and crew lists has involved some very difficult decisions for us. Know that we take each individual's audition, interview and callback as a testament to their goals as an artist. The first rehearsal for all three Productions is Tuesday, September 3rd, from 5:00pm to 9:00 p.m. in Titus Auditorium at Anderson High School. At this rehearsal we will take program headshots for students involved in both stage shows, so please wear a plain black shirt and be ready to look professional. Also, please bring a laptop, for various VCB-related needs. Lastly—for storing and annotating your script—bring a binder and writing materials.

There is also a **parent meeting** this same night. Inform your parents that the meeting will be **from 8:00 to 9:00pm.** They will be given important information about your—and their—participation in the productions.
